

## AgeGuide FY2022 Request for Proposals Frequently Asked Questions #5

### **Can you review my budget before I submit it?**

No. This RFP is competitive, and AgeGuide staff are not able to review and approve your budget in advance. If you have a specific question, we will do our best to answer it for you in a way that is fair to all other applicants.

### **The risk assessment asks if we need to have a 2<sup>nd</sup> person sign off on match reporting. Is this a requirement?**

Please answer the risk assessment as accurately as possible based on your agency's current practices. Ideally, the monthly grantee expense report has two signatures – one for the person who prepares the report and one for an authorization.

### **I am a for-profit organization. Am I eligible to apply?**

### **Are the SAM number and the CAGE Code the same number?**

Yes, your SAM registration numbers may also be referred to as a CAGE code.

### **Do I have to submit an application for the RFP if I am an existing provider? Don't I get the option to renew?**

AgeGuide grants are not available for renewal for FY2022.

FY2022 is the Year 1 of a three-year grant cycle for AgeGuide grants. Title III-B, IIIC-1, IIIC-2, III-D, and III-E grants are open to competition this year. Those applicants who are awarded funding in FY2022 will be given the opportunity to renew in FY2023 and FY2024.
