AgeGuide Northeastern Illinois is soliciting applications for funding from non-profit and local government organizations qualified to receive Federal/State of Illinois financial assistance grants to provide services for older adults (age 60+) as authorized under the Older Americans Act of 1965 (Public Law 89-73). The funding period is November 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024.
