



Federal Fiscal Year 2027 Funding Opportunity

AgeGuide Northeastern Illinois is soliciting applications from **non-profit and local government organizations** qualified to receive Federal/State of Illinois financial assistance grants to provide services for older adults (age 60+) as authorized under the Older Americans Act of 1965 (Public Law 89-73) in **WILL COUNTY**.

The funding period is October 1, 2026 – September 30, 2027, with an option to extend for an additional 1 year.

Fundable Services & Counties:

- Title III E Caregiver Resource Center
- Title III E Caregiver Counseling Center

Requirements:

Successful applicants must comply with all applicable pre-qualification requirements including, but not limited to, current UEI number from SAM.gov, acceptable fiscal management/fiscal stability (including the ability to meet matching requirements), be in good standing with the Secretary of State and not be on any Debarred/Suspended/ Stop Payment/Excluded Parties listings. For-profit entities are not eligible to apply and services must be offered at no cost to participants.
